EVENT NOTIFICATION

Chirn Park Street Festival is coming back to the Gold Coast this October! Presented by **Division 6 Cr Brooke Patterson**, this celebration will be another great opportunity to bring **together** our incredible **community** and **support** many of the **local businesses** and **organisations** in the area. Chirn Park Street Festival will feature **FREE** live music, pop up bar, roving performers, kid's entertainment, local food truck and business specials, community groups, stalls and more!

This letter is notification of the proposed event and your opportunity to provide any feedback.

It is anticipated the event will run from 4pm to 8pm on Saturday 7th Oct 2023 with activities along Musgrave Ave, Turpin Rd, and Brooke Ave to help encourage attendees to mix with restaurants and retailers in a safe and fun environment. As with any event on main roads, in order to ensure safety of suppliers and spectators, it is proposed to conduct a temporary road closure on the event day (see information below) for the 5000+ people we expect will attend. A PA system will operate during the event for general communications, commentary and emergency reasons.

- **Type of closure:** Full Temporary Road Closure with Detour.
- **Proposed Time(s):** 10am to 11pm (with car parks from 9am).
- **Reason for closure:** Safety of Event Attendees/Vendors.

Should local businesses wish to have an additional street stall space, please advise Event Organisers and an area will be allocated. External stall holders will be asked to pay a stall fee towards the event; local businesses however will have this fee waived.
